

**THE JOAN S. BARONE AWARD
\$2,000 CASH PRIZE**

The 33rd annual Joan S. Barone award for excellence in journalism will be presented at the 73rd annual Radio & Television Congressional Correspondents' Dinner on October 25, 2017 at the National Building Museum.

The award honors the memory of the late Joan Shorenstein Barone, former executive producer of CBS' "**FACE THE NATION.**" Funding for the award was raised by Ms. Barone's friends and colleagues.

ENTRY RULES:

1. Entries are for calendar year 2016 reporting.
2. The award will be presented for excellence in Washington-based reporting of Congressional/ political affairs. Entries should focus on public affairs and coverage of Congress. For example, an entry might be about the military or diplomacy but it must include elements relating to Capitol Hill.
3. The competition is open to all producers and reporters who hold a credential through the Congressional Radio and Television Correspondents Galleries.
4. All entries must be audio or video content which was broadcast on radio or television or published online. The organization submitting the entry must have shot or recorded the content included in the entry. Entries may be: a) a complete broadcast, b) broadcast segment or c) several topics by the same reporter, producer, or team.

PLEASE NOTE: Limit one entry per person or team.

5. **Applications may be submitted either in person or via e-mail.** Story content must be submitted at the same time, either as a DVD/CD or as a single, direct web link. No other formats will be accepted. Any web link that is not active at the deadline or during judging will be ineligible. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
6. Entries for the Barone Award are **NOT** eligible for consideration for the David Bloom Award. Dual entries will not be considered.
7. The RTCA does not necessarily select a winner for each award every year. We will choose an honoree only if there is an exceptional candidate who meets the award criteria.
8. **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES: 5:00 PM on FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2017.**

The entries will be judged by a panel of three distinguished journalists. A total cash award of \$2,000 will go to one individual or be shared by a team. The RTCA will supply one desk award to the winner. In the case of a winning team, other awards may be purchased by the individual or organization.
